

Letter of No Objection for CDM Project

Undersigned as a legal and authorized representative of the Designated National Authority for the Clean Development Mechanism of Sudan Referring to **Agroforestry for small scale farmers on degraded land** proposed by **Agricultural Technology Transfer Society** hereafter to be referred to as Applicant"

1. Appreciates that the objective of the Certified Emission Reductions (CERs) generated by Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) projects that in due are expected to be eligible for the purposes of Article 6/12 of the Kyoto Protocol to the United Nations Framework Convention on climate change (UNFCCC) in accordance with the Kyoto protocol and Marrakech Accords and the relevant rules, decisions, guidelines and modalities adopted thereunder.
2. Declares that
 - a. Sudan has ratified the Kyoto Protocol on date Feb, 2005.
 - b. Sudan has taken notice of the CDM project and is aware that the Applicant intends to sell ensuing Emission Reductions i.e identify a buyer and negotiate an ERPA (Emission Reductions Purchase Agreement)
 - c. Sudan will assess the proposed CDM project against the National Sustainable Development Criteria (SDC).
 - d. Sudan endorses further development of the CDM project in accordance with the article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol and the relevant rules, decisions, guidelines and modalities and procedures, and confirms that the participation in the project is voluntary and committing itself to render such assistance as may be necessary in the futures validation, verification, issuance and transfer of the CERs.
 - e. Sudan will assess the EIA of the CDM project as required according to the Environmental law of Sudan

In the case where the results from the assessment as mentioned above are positive Sudan will consider to grant formal approval of the CDM project i.e. issue the letter of Approval, with the intention to enable the transfer of CERs to the account of the contracted buyer .
